### Nature:

---

General Excellence. The recipient need not necessarily be an outstanding academic but show a strong commitment to their studies. They will be able to detail achievements in areas outside and/or inside the academic program.

Scholarships awarded under this category include; **Boarding, Citizenship, Student Leadership, and Lutheran Women**

### Application:

---

The applicant must

- submit a St Paul's College Culture and Citizenship Scholarship application form.
- submit a cover letter and a detailed curriculum vitae addressing the criteria.
- be prepared to attend a scholarship interview.

The success of applicants will be based on their capabilities to meet the criteria, their written application and their interview.

### Tenure:

---

Available to *new* students entering Year 7, 9, 10 or 11, in the year following application. Tenable for remaining years at St Paul's College (if scholarship criteria is maintained)

### Value:

---

20-30% remission of tuition or boarding fees.

### Criteria

---

Criteria and (evidence) required for award:

- Demonstrated academic commitment (i.e. school reports and NAPLAN results)
- Demonstrated history of achievement at school or in the community (i.e. awards or certificates received)
- Personal qualities (i.e. school reports or references)
  - Honesty
  - Trustworthiness
  - Punctuality
  - Cooperation
  - Commitment
- Ability to contribute to the co-curricular program at St Paul's College.
