HOMEWORK Policy

Policy

In alignment with our commitment to learning, homework will be set for all students from Years 7-12

Rationale

Prescribing homework for students to complete is based on the following reasoning:

- 1 Develops study skills
- 2 Avoids learning disadvantage with other schools
- 3 Enhances self-discipline
- 4 Provides accountability for learning
- 5 Enables parents to be informed about their child's learning
- 6 Supports ownership & engagement of learning

Principles

Our accepted rules for action include:

- Homework will be set for students
- Homework needs to be monitored for completion
- Homework should be work that students can understand & complete
- Homework should support a developmental approach of study skills
- Homework could involve assessment tasks
- Homework requires adjustments as per ILPs
- Homework that supports our College learning programs & activities

PROCEDURE

Teachers will set homework after consideration of the homework already set on the current LMS Assessment Planner for that year level.

Homework tasks may be set for that night; for several nights; or, as a weekly or fortnightly task
