St Paul's College offers a range of Scholarships for **new** students considering enrolling in 2022. **Families of prospective students are invited to apply by providing the following information, by the closing dates.**

GENERAL SCHOLARSHIPS CLOSE – 1st MAY 2021

BOARDING, EQUINE, AGRICULTURE, FIRST NATIONS & INDUSTRIAL TECHNOLOGY SCHOLARSHIPS CLOSE – 20th MAY 2021

You may *apply for more than one*, but only one scholarship may be selected and awarded.

Students from a Lutheran Primary School automatically receive 20% reduction in tuition fees upon a Year 7 enrolment. Students from Lutheran Primary Schools are therefore only eligible to sit the General Scholarship Year 7 Exam.

Applicants should provide:

- Completed Scholarship Application.
- A written character reference provided by a person who has known the applicant in a sporting, learning or social setting.
- Most recent school report.
- Additional information such as clubs, associations, or interest groups applicable to the applicant can be provided (optional).

General Scholarship, Year 7	Students entering Year 7 in 2022 are eligible to apply. A state-wide exam administered by ACER will be held at St Paul's College on Saturday 8 th May 2021 from 9am to 11.30am. You must register online with ACER prior to the exam date to enter. An administration fee of \$95.00 applies. Register – http://scholarships.acer.edu.au/intro/2189	\$3000 reduction in tuition fees, each year for 3 years.
General Scholarship, Years 9 and 11	New students entering Years 9 and 11 in 2022 are eligible to apply. A state-wide exam administered by ACER will be held at St Paul's College on Saturday 8 th May 2021 9am to 11.30am. You must register online with ACER prior to the exam date to enter. An administration fee of \$95.00 applies. Register – http://scholarships.acer.edu.au/intro/2189	Year 9, \$3000 reduction in tuition fees, each year for 3 years. Year 11, \$3000 reduction in tuition fees, each year for 2 years.
Boarding Years 7 - 12	Students who are planning to weekly or full-time board in 2022 are eligible to apply. Boarding must continue for the duration of this scholarship.	\$3000 reduction in boarding fees, each year for 3 years.
Equine Years 7 - 12	Students applying must show an ability, interest and aptitude in equine to improve their knowledge and skills. Recipients of this scholarship will be expected to choose Equine as an elective subject for the tenure of the scholarship and maintain a good level of improvement and involvement in equine activities.	\$2000 reduction in tuition fees, each year for 3 years.
Agriculture Years 7 - 12	Students applying must show an interest and desire to improve their knowledge of the agriculture practises and industry. Recipients of this scholarship will be expected to be involved in Agriculture studies in Years 7, 8 and 9 – as an activity/subject/elective and participate in our Livestock Show Team.	\$2000 reduction in tuition fees, each year for 3 years.
First Nations Years 7 - 12	First Nations Scholarships are offered based on ability and potential to make a positive contribution towards their learning and life at St Paul's. Proof of Aboriginality status is required with the Scholarship Application.	\$2000 reduction in tuition fees, each year for 3 years.
Industrial Technology (Technics) Years 10 – 12	In honour of Mr Kotzur's generosity to the College, The Ray Kotzur Memorial Technics Scholarship will be offered to students entering Years 10 - 12 showing an interest and desire to pursue Industrial Technology.	\$2000 reduction in tuition fees, each year for 3 years.
