



Co-curricular Scholarship for 2025 Entry

Nature:

Co-curricular scholarships may be awarded in the areas of **Music, Drama, Equine, Agriculture, and Sport**. The recipient must be an outstanding performer within their chosen field. They will have experience performing at a high level either as an individual or in a recognised group/ensemble/team. They must show a strong commitment to their field. They will be able to detail outstanding achievements in their chosen co-curricular pursuit.

Application:

The applicant must

- submit a St Paul's College Co-curricular Scholarship application form
- submit a cover letter and a detailed curriculum vitae addressing the criteria
- be prepared to attend a scholarship interview.

The success of applicants will be based on their ability in their chosen field, written application, and their interview. Additionally, the applicant may be required to audition or provide a demonstration of their skills in person or via video.

Tenure:

Available to *new* students entering Year 7, 9, 10 or 11, in the year following application. Tenable for remaining years at St Paul's College (if scholarship criteria are maintained). Note: **Equine applicants can only apply for Year 7 & 9.**

Value:

20-30% remission of Tuition Fees for remaining years at St Paul's College.

Criteria

Criteria and evidence required for award:

- Demonstrated academic commitment (i.e. school reports and NAPLAN results).
- Demonstrated achievement in chosen field, at school or within the community (i.e. awards/certificates/selections received).
- Personal qualities (school reports or references).
 - Honesty
 - Trustworthiness
 - Punctuality
 - Cooperation
 - Commitment
- Ability to contribute to the co-curricular program at St Paul's College.
